ANNUAL REPORT 2021 - 22

For New Session Online Classes started on 5th April. A new app (NLP) was introduced for online classes and seminars were arranged for teachers as well as for students to train them. By the use of this app students as well as teachers developed their skills to learn & teach in online mode, as has been the need of the after mark of Covid -19.

Eco club of the school had organized activity of Plantation which was performed in both online as well as offline mode. Students did plantation at their homes and few selected students were permitted to do the plantation in the school premises. Efforts were made to imbibe among the students the importance of environment and to understand the value of it for them as well as the future generation. Students were also shown and explained the working of compost pit. Few selected students were permitted to come in the school premises and to see compost pit and how waste was segregated and put into the compost pit. The working of the compost pit was explained to them.

In the first week of May online meeting was held for Periodic – 1 Exams for teachers and parents. Online Periodic-I exams were conducted from 18th May. It continued till one week. Parents responded positively during these exams.


Online competitions like words of Indian Origin Quiz and mind wars were conducted. Most of the students of all classes participated in these above completions and were provided online certificates for their good performance.


Periodic - 2 exam was conducted from 30th November for class 1 to 8.






Winter vacations were given from 25th Dec to 9th January. Holidays homework was given to students for revision purpose.


From 10th January classes resumed in online mode according to Government Circular. Classes were taken through zoom app and nest learning platform.







PTM of result of students class Nursery to 9 & 11th were conducted from March 21 to March 25 following the covid protocol norms.






Practical Exams for class 12th was conducted from 5th March to 20th March'2022/
